

# Cycling Development in Amber Valley, Derbyshire



## Aim:

To provide an offer through cycling above and beyond Bikeability

## Why:

- 1: No other 'sport'/activity has the funding this does so there was a necessity to develop
- 2: Wider school offer in Amber Valley
- 3: Few opportunities to 'cycle to school' due to nature of the geography locally
- 4: Aim to develop key life skills



## How:

- 1: Go Ride Racing placed in the annual calendar
- 2: Support from Go Ride coaches
- 3: Funding applications to A4A and SE
- 4: Fleet of bikes and trailer
- 5: Negotiation on contracts for bikeability for costs and delivery

## Output:

- 1: Primary Go Ride Racing league with 70+ regular attendees and good girls' development
- 2: School Games Level 3 competition
- 3: Secondary participation increase
- 4: SEN delivery
- 5: Key schools accessing A4A funding too
- 6: All Y2 children leave school learning to ride a bike

## What's needed:

- Opportunity to provide greater club link and migration of young people
- Greater club engagement
- More focused output from the secondary programme
- Link to the new Derby Arena / Velodrome
- Better logistics / transport management
